

# School for Life: Student leaders elected for the Academic Year 2018-19

On the 15<sup>th</sup> of May 2018, the School for Life reopened for the Academic Year 2018-19 after summer holiday.

On the 25<sup>th</sup> of May, School for Life had an election process for the Head student and two Deputy Head students, letting the students choose their own leaders. **Khe**, a Grade 9 student, was elected as Head student, and **Anuphong** and **Pacharaporn**, also Grade 9 students, were elected as Deputy Head students.
