Coffee cups, mugs and bowls are made from Thai porcelain/ceramic with designs in five colours of ethnic fabric patterns; it is called “Benjarong”.



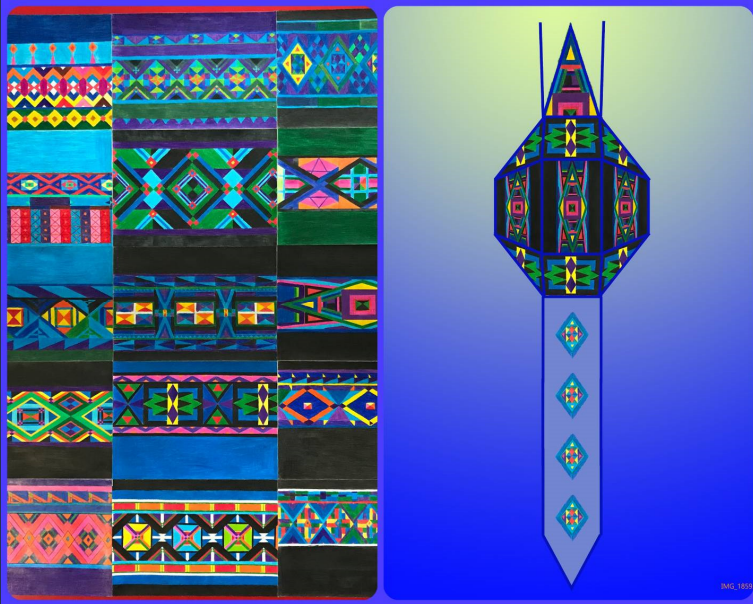

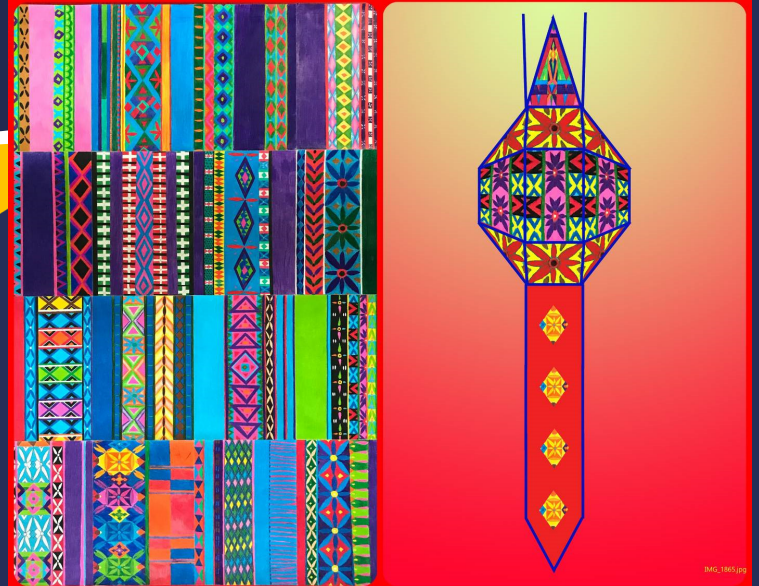

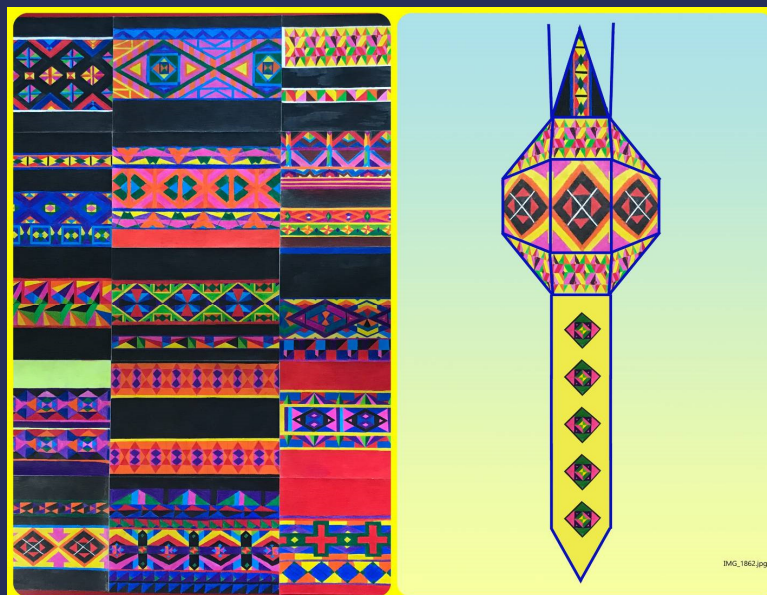

Brief Information about School for Life

The idea to found the School for Life in Chiang Mai in the year 1999, came from Khun Thanin "Joy" Hanfhaifha and Prof. Dr. Jürgen Zimmer, from Freie University Berlin. The project planning in Chiang Mai was based on a nationwide study called "The Development of Entrepreneurial Schools in Thailand" conducted in 2001.

The founding of the School for Life was preceded by a two-year pilot phase with research in the catchment area and discussions with representatives of communities, ethnic groups, non-governmental organizations, school and social authorities. It became a model school in entrepreneurial education concept, HRH Maha Chakri Princess Sirindhorn had also privately visited the school in 2005.

Later on, it was officially recognized as a 'Private Social Welfare School' since May 2006. SFL now includes a kindergarten, primary school (1-6) and junior high school (7-9). A Senior High School is to be opened when the funds are available. In the beginning the target groups of the school were AIDS orphaned, poor, underprivileged children including children and families having social and poverty problems.



Now, the children of the School-for-Life come from different regions of Northern Thailand and belong to different ethnic groups. This fact is taken into account in the pedagogical concept and plays a role every week. Living in their traditional costumes the children "live" their cultural and linguistic traditions and experience the same from the other pupils of the school.



The school has a policy to develop quality of life and provide quality education and creativity opportunities to all target groups along with having equality and equity of education chances. Beside this, the school also tries hard to educate the target groups and the staff to have knowledge, occupational skills, life skills, morality, positive attitude, volunteer spirit, creativity, physical, ethics and social development as well as an entrepreneurial skills to earn and create the creative income based on the Buddhist economics, 3 aspects of truth, beauty and goodness, as well as the Philosophy of "Sufficiency Economy" of King Rama 9 for better standard of living. The school has the philosophy of education based on, "Wisdom can never be communicated. It has to be experienced".

First of all we have to inform that the School for Life creates the learning concept based on principles of "Learning by Doing" and "Earning through Learning". The curriculum development and learning structures are the integration of Pedagogy (Discovery Learning and Individualized teaching), Education for Innovative Entrepreneurship and Community Education which it means "learning in, with and for the community". Therefore there will be progress in all learning activities. Normally during summer holiday, if children who still have families, relatives or homes, the school will let them go back, but for the rest who do not have, they have to stay at school and join the activities we offer. This year the situation of the epidemic of Covid-19 is even harder to go back home, and of course the children are really missing their home. The idea of the project is from our children's conversations, they said that the only things that are still in their memories about their "Home and their parents" are the smell and the fabric pattern of their parent clothes, therefore the project of "Ethnic Fabric Pattern Art" was started and we believe that the project could fulfill the children with the "Feeling of Missing Home" and now it is created to be the "Miracle Products" of our school as well.

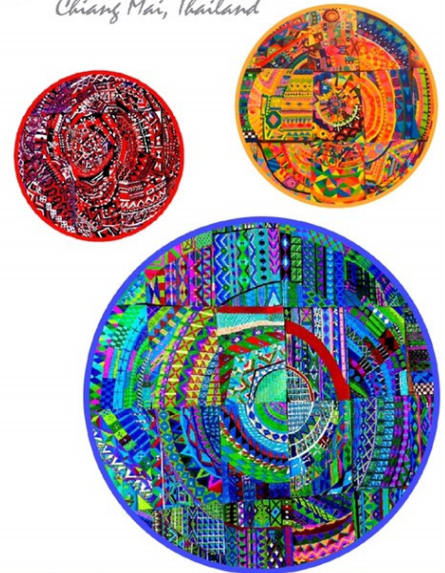

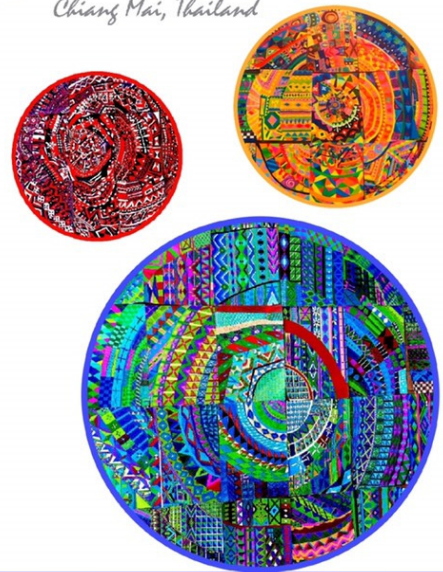
