We also held a Parent/Guardian-Teacher Meeting at 10:30 AM in the school assembly hall. School Director *Khun Siriporn Hanfaifa* gave an opening speech at the meeting. She explained to the parents and guardians of the children how the twenty-eight children lived with her in the School for Life in the city on summer holiday, what they did during the summer holiday, why the school was reopened later than last year and what the teachers prepared to protect children from Covid-19 before the school reopened. In addition to these, she explained the measures to be followed by all students and teachers at the school to prevent spread of Covid-19. She introduced all teachers to the new children and guardians.

Next, Teacher *Khun Sak* explained about the school rules and regulations. Then, Teacher *Tomsri* explained about the documents required for student registration and moving to another school.

After that, the meeting was closed, and all children and guardians had lunch together at the school canteen.
